Pirate Christian radio: Russian Christians continue to find unique ways to share NLR

Since **Vladimir V. Putin**'s inauguration for a third term as president just over two months ago, the *Duma* has approved laws that sharply increase



penalties for participants and organizers of unsanctioned political protests; grants the government new powers to restrict "harmful" Internet content; and has now passed a controversial bill that requires nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) and non-profits that receive funding from abroad to register with the Justice Ministry as "foreign agents," using language that implies these entities are spy organizations.

What these new developments mean for independent Christian radio operating within the Russian Federation, is a new era of heightened state control over every aspect of mass media, including telecom access, content control, organizational oversight and legal or criminal penalties in case of non-compliance.

New Life Radio may potentially be subject to new censorship controls in two areas: political (in the form of anti-government propaganda—possibly enforced when a Christian station broadcasts Old and New Testament guidelines on governance that might not sit well with Kremlin officials); and religious (in the form of religious extremism, where the state interferes with churches that proclaim doctrines that might harm the religious sensibilities of other faiths. Publicly airing Jesus' declaration --"I am the way the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but by me," technically could be construed as religious extremism and subject the radio station to criminal liability. The Law on NGOs may force NLR to provide quarterly reports to the state outlining how funding from our western faith partners are spent.

IN DIFFICULT TIMES,

Christians are called to be bold in their proclamation of the Gospel. NLR will not alter its Christian content in light of these new laws, but as a precaution, CRFR is updating its contingency planning to maintain the NLR network should the state interfere with its broadcast operations. We ask our friends and partners to pray that God places a hedge of protection around the staff and broadcasts of NLR!

ХРАДИО НОВАЯ ЖИЗНЬ International partnerships and NLR development efforts: an UPDATE

From its inception as Russia's 1st FM Christian radio station, New Life Radio has been a partnership between Russian and American Christians. Since 1996, our radio network has been a faith venture, with Russians overseeing the programs and broadcasts, and Americans providing the funding to cover the telecom and studio costs, as well as missionary support for the radio staff. NLR provides the Slavic Church and its many evangelical denominations with a free mass media service to reach their own people in evangelism and discipleship.

For many years, our Russian friends have lamented the fact that they have been unable to subsidize the network from within their country. CRFR has always viewed our cooperation as part of the wider family of God, spread across many nations, but focused together to take up Christ's call to proclaim the Gospel to the ends of the earth, using shared resources.

This past July, NLR hosted a radio developers conference in Moscow, bringing volunteers from 12 major cities who are all committed to assisting the network develop new financial partnerships with Christians across Russia and the Ukraine.

After identifying factors that have limited church mission support for NLR, and finding solutions to this, our new developers are already working to represent the network to local and regional churches and in denominational circles. The key



is to first build awareness about NEW LIFE RADIO; encourage tithing and mission support on a monthly basis; and to work for greater distribution of NLR's signal nationwide.

The group has set out an ambitious broadcast expansion strategy this September, with the goal to apply for FM radio licenses in 5 Russian cities with populations under 200,000. **The estimated cost per station would be \$23,000**.

On the American side, CRFR will participate in a Slavic Missions Forum in Washington, DC in late September. NLR station manager Dima Vatoulya will come here to address a national group of Slavic pastors to encourage greater participation with Christian media in Russia, both in programming and financial giving. We ask our CRFR partners to pray that God would bless our efforts in Russia and the US, so we can properly equip our radio network and increase its effectiveness and outreach for the Gospel.

UPDATE 7/7/12 : NLR has been informed that its satellite programming is being transmitted over a pirate FM radio signal near the city of Samara, Russia on 95.4 mhz. Fedor Katanov has reported that the signal is being allowed and transmits across a 30 kilometer region by this city of over 1,160,000 people. While NLR does not endorse illegal transmissions, we are amazed how people find ways to get the Gospel transmitted into their neighbor's homes.
