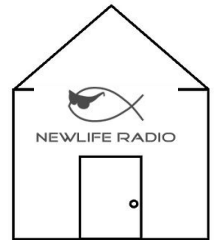

Bringing the Gospel to remote areas of Russia via satellite ...and partnering with Church-run rehabilitation centers

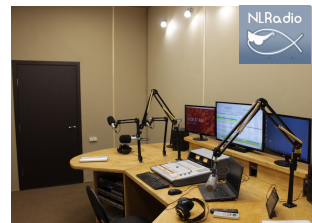
Masha Zhurakovskaya, a resident of Syktivkar, Russia and ardent listener of NLR, has a new passion for outreach: working with CRFR to install satellite receivers in Christian operated rehab centers for those released from prisons or suffering from drug and alcohol abuse. Bringing God's Word and Christian encouragement is a natural means to help men and women who have experienced great discouragement in life rediscover the NEW LIFE Christ has for them. Russian Evangelical Churches operate rehab centers across the country, many in extremely remote areas and NLR is uniquely positioned to reach them via their Hotbird and Yamal satellites, using inexpensive equipment to bring in 24/7 Christian programming that helps in the healing and rehabilitation process. The two groups featured here are from the Kirov region, which includes a network of 6 more rehab centers that are all requesting satellite receivers and audio equipment for residents.
