God. Her poetry speaks to people about the love of Christ. Natalia will share about evangelization toward those who go through medical, social, and preventive abortion services.

Talk Show: "The Word for You" Wednesday evening Program Description



During the hour-long radio listeners can listen in **Mathematical** on a debate with our hosts from the Christian studio "Word for You" on the topic: "BEWARE of the SECTS."

The phrase *sect* has different shades of meaning in Russia, not necessarily understood by Christians in the west. The government and Russian Orthodox Church leaders view Protestants and Evangelicals as sects, whereas Christians view groups like Jehovah's Witnesses, Scientology, Mormons, and new age groups as *sects*. The hosts will help listeners make sense of these labels and how it impacts our view to reaching out to the lost as they engage those groups who fall outside the teachings of historic Christianity.



Talk Show: FACTOR SVETA (Factor of Light) Friday, 6 pm Moscow time Program Description:

TOPIC: A changing country; the rise of morality, chastity, youth, care and protection of children, the restoration of the family - Christians want to see the results of their faith. But what can you do that would speed up the ripening of faith? We will talk about this with Ilya Savelievym, the coordinator of the Christian youth movement "*Come*," and hear about upcoming plans for the evening youth worship. Join the conversation!

ITEM FOR PRAYER: more government threats to expressing faith in Russia (Reuters) - by Steve Gutterman, 5/22/13



"Russian lawmakers on Tuesday took a step toward imposing jail terms for

offending religious feelings, approving legislation proposed after punk band Pussy Riot performed a raucous protest song in Moscow's main Orthodox Christian cathedral.

Critics say the bill will give government-approved religious groups protection others lack and blur the line between church and state under President Vladimir Putin, who has advocated a strong societal role for the Russian Orthodox Church.

Lawmakers in the State Duma approved the bill by a vote of 304-4 after the second of three required readings in the 450-seat lower parliament house. Putin is likely to sign it after it gets through the Duma and a vote in the upper house.

The bill would introduce jail terms of up to one year and fines of up to 300,000 rubles (\$9,600) for "public actions expressing clear disrespect for society and committed with intent to offend the religious feelings of the faithful." If committed in a house of worship (by a pastor) the maximum punishment would be three years in prison and a fine of 500,000 rubles."
