FROM MAGADAN to MOSCOW



Prior to 1988, the few Americans who knew anything about Magadan, Russia were those who read the books of Alexander Solzhenitsyn with his gripping descriptions of the horrors of Soviet gulag camps and the systematic repression of millions of Soviet citizens--many of whom were innocent believers suffering for their faith in Christ.

In 1988, a small group of Americans boarded a plane in Nome, Alaska to penetrate a Soviet border that had been closed for 40 years, in order to open up a new chapter of friendly relations between the peoples of the US & USSR. One member of that group was Daniel Johnson, and shortly after that historic visit to Russia, he was invited back to investigate the possibilities for wider cooperation with the Soviets. Over the next few years, God laid the groundwork for Daniel to eventually move to Russia in 1991, and with the breakup of the Soviet Union soon afterward, along with the support of the Evangelical Covenant Church, he embarked on a journey to establish a Christian radio station in Magadan.

In 1996, NEW LIFE RADIO-FM became the first Christian FM station in Russia—proclaiming the Gospel to this city of 130,000 people and setting a precedent for the expansion of Christian radio in cities across the country.



While celebrating NLR's new ministry, it became clear that thousands of communities throughout Russia and other ex-Soviet republics needed Christian radio as well. For this purpose, Daniel moved 8 time zones to Moscow to create a satellite radio operation that could promote the development of inexpensive radio affiliates needing only a satellite antenna and small FM transmitter located inside a church building. From radio studios located on Red Square in Moscow, NEW LIFE RADIO initiated nationwide satellite direct to home Christian radio broadcasts in December 2000!

From that point through today, NEW LIFE RADIO continues its mission to support the evangelism and discipleship efforts of the evangelical Church in Russia, Ukraine, Belarus, and many other former Soviet republics, even to Slavic congregations scattered across the globe.
